DUES STATEMENT 2025-2026

Annual Dues (September 1, 2024 through August 31, 2025)

\$175 for regular membership

\$100 for virtual membership - Virtual Membership for individuals who live out of the area. This provides free attendance to our winter Zoom seminar, as well as other membership benefits such as voting rights and listserv membership.

\$25 for student membership - Student Membership eligible for individuals currently enrolled in coursework.

\$50 for new professional - New Professional membership level is for individuals having received their degree three years ago or less. Only eligible to join at this rate for two years.

\$85 for returning BIPOC membership (Black, Indigenous, People of Color) - WSPP has a commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion. Recognizing the historical disadvantages experienced by our colleagues of color, this membership option underscores that a diverse network best supports professional development and service to our patients.

\$0 for new BIPOC Member - In addition, we offer one free year of membership for any BIPOC members who have not already received this free year.

Dues paid after June 1, 2026, will be applied for the next year.
